## Integrity of the Mexico Mission

Preserving the integrity of our Mexico Mission is of the utmost importance. Part of that integrity comes from the trust and respect that the directors and sponsors place in the youth to uphold the guidelines of the trip and the laws of the U.S. and Mexican governments. However, in order to ensure that our mission community fully complies with laws of both the U.S. and Mexican governments, the directors and a sponsor from your church may search you and your personal belongings at anytime during our mission trip, if necessary.

If, for any reason, you separate from the group, are detained or incarcerated by American or Mexican authorities, or if you must be sent home for any reason, although the adults on the trip will assist where possible, ultimately, your parents/guardians assume full responsibility for the arrangements and costs for your release and travel home.

As a participant of the Mexico Mission, you and your parents/guardians are required to sign this document.

## Hold Harmless Agreement
